A joint special meeting of the Boards of Directors of the Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3 (referred to hereafter as the "Boards") was convened on Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. The meeting was held via conference call and was open to the public.

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

<u>Call to Order:</u> Director Smith called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

FINANCIAL MATTERS

MD 1 - Public Hearing on 2020 Budget Amendment; Resolution No. 2021-09-01: Director Smith opened the public hearing on the 2020 budget amendment. Ms. Johnson noted that the notice of the hearing was published in

accordance with Colorado law and no objections were received prior to the hearing. There being no public in attendance for comment, the public hearing was closed.

Mr. Flynn presented the 2020 budget amendment to the Board. Following review and discussion, upon a motion duly made by Director Schmitz, seconded by Director Smith and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Board approved the 2020 budget amendment and adopted Resolution No. 2021-09-01.

MDs 1 and 2 - 2020 Audits; Authorize Execution of Representations Letters: The Boards of District Nos. 1 and 2 reviewed the 2020 Audits. Following review and discussion, upon a motion duly made by Director Schmitz, seconded by Director Smith and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Boards accepted the 2020 Audits, subject to the issuance of clean, unmodified opinion letters from the auditor.

MD 1 - Payment of District Constructions Costs: Ms. Johnson will follow up with Mr. Laudick on the construction costs status.

MD 1 - Bid Summary; Award of a Contract for the Crossroads Offsite Sanitary Sewer Project: Mr. Lacey presented the bid summary to the Board. Of the two companies that provided proposals, HEI Civil submitted a bid in the amount of \$9,053,611.25, and SMH West submitted a bid in the amount of \$7,452,000.00. Following review and discussion, upon a motion by Director Smith, seconded by Director Schmitz and, upon vote, unanimously carried, the Board approved to award the contract to SMH West in the amount of \$7,452,000.00, subject to confirmation of a recommendation to award the contract to SMH West from the District Engineer.
