RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AURORA CROSSROADS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 1

REGARDING ACCEPTANCE OF DISTRICT ELIGIBLE COSTS

(Cost Certification No. 1: Streets, Water, Sanitary Sewer, Parks & Recreation)

WHEREAS, Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 1, City of Aurora, Arapahoe County, State of Colorado (the "**District**"), is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado, duly organized and existing as a metropolitan district under §§ 32-1-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S. (the "**Special District Act**"); and

WHEREAS, the District has the power to provide certain public infrastructure, improvements, facilities and services (collectively, the "**Public Infrastructure**"), as described in the Special District Act, and as authorized in the Amended and Restated Service Plan for Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 1, Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 2 and Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan district No. 3 (the "**Amended and Restated Service Plan**") approved by the City Council for the City of Aurora on June 22, 2020, with an effective date of July 25, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the District was organized for the purpose of providing for the acquisition, financing, construction and installation of the Public Infrastructure serving the property located within the boundaries of the District (the "**Project**"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 32-1-1001(1)(f), C.R.S., the District has the power to acquire real and personal property, including rights and interests in property and easements necessary to its functions or operations; and

WHEREAS, the District and Aurora Crossroads LLC, (the "**Developer**") entered into a Public Improvements Acquisition and Reimbursement Agreement, dated July 1, 2020, (the "**Acquisition Agreement**") which sets forth the procedures procedure for documenting, certifying and reimbursing the Developer for certain costs related to Public Improvements that may be lawfully funded by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has funded certain costs related to the Public Improvements for the benefit of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Acquisition Agreement, the District has agreed to reimburse the Developer for "District Eligible Costs," subject to the satisfaction of certain terms and conditions as set forth in the Acquisition Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Acquisition Agreement requires that the Developer furnish copies of all invoices, statements and evidence of payment equal to the proposed District Eligible Costs, including lien waivers from suppliers and subcontractors, as applicable, to the District related to the costs funded by the Developer related to the Public Improvements (collectively, the "Payment Information") in order to, *inter alia*, allow the District to substantiate the amount of District Eligible Costs; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has furnished the Payment Information and all other requested information to the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") engaged the Schedio Group, LLC, (the "District Engineer") an independent engineer, who has reviewed the Payment Information to substantiate the amount of District Eligible Costs, and the District Engineer has advised the Board that certain of the costs submitted by the Developer are reasonable and appropriate and related to the Public Improvements authorized and contemplated under the terms of the Amended and Restated Service Plan and Acquisition Agreement and are therefore eligible for reimbursement by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board engaged Simmons & Wheeler, P.C. (the "**District Accountant**") who has also reviewed the Payment Information to substantiate the amount of District Eligible Costs, and the District Accountant has advised the Board that certain of the costs submitted by the Developer are reasonable and appropriate and related to the Public Improvements authorized and contemplated under the terms of the Amended and Restated Service Plan and Acquisition Agreement and are therefore eligible for reimbursement by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the information submitted by the District Engineer and District Accountant and other information as appropriate and has determined that the best interests of the District, its residents, users, and property owners would be served by the District's recognition and acceptance of the District Eligible Costs, and the District should expend funds for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to recognize and reimburse the Developer for the District Eligible Costs and, as applicable, acquire certain of the Public Improvements from the Developer, subject to the availability of District funds for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of the District as follows:

1. <u>District Eligible Costs</u>. The Developer has represented that it has funded or caused to be funded District Eligible Costs at its sole cost and expense, which District Eligible Costs are directly related to the Public Improvements, and has provided the Payment Information to the District.

- 2. <u>Cost Certification.</u> As required under Section 5 of the Acquisition Agreement, the District Engineer and District Accountant have each reviewed the Payment Information, and have issued "Cost Certifications," attached as **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B** respectively, certifying the amount of District Eligible Costs to be reimbursed to the Developer.
- 3. <u>Acceptance of District Eligible Costs</u>. The Board hereby finds that the applicable requirements set forth in the Acquisition Agreement have been met, and, to the extent not addressed herein, are hereby waived, and that the District Eligible Costs are hereby accepted and approved for reimbursement by the District.
- 4. <u>Acceptance of District Eligible Costs</u>. The Board, having reviewed the certifications and recommendations of the District Engineer and District Accountant, finds and determines that the total amount of District Eligible Costs to be reimbursed to the Developer is Three Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Fifty-One Cents (\$328,896.51). The Board further finds that the applicable requirements set forth in the Acquisition Agreement have been met, and that the District Eligible Costs are hereby accepted and approved for reimbursement by the District.
- 5. <u>Subject to Annual Appropriations</u>. Any payments due hereunder are subject to annual appropriation by the District and do not create a multiple-fiscal year obligation or debt whatsoever. Furthermore, any payments due hereunder are subject to any repayment terms and conditions as set forth in the Acquisition Agreement.
- 6. <u>Definitions</u>. Capitalized terms not defined herein, shall have the meanings set forth in the Acquisition Agreement.

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ENGINEER'S REPORT

INTRODUCTION

Per the request of Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 1 ("District"), Schedio Group LLC ("Schedio Group") provided a proposal for Independent Professional Engineer's Report and Cost Verification Services on August 25, 2020. This Engineer's Report and Verification of Costs Associated with Public Improvements ("Report") is the 1st deliverable associated with the proposal, more specifically Task 1 – Independent Professional Engineer's Review and Verification of Costs Incurred to Date Associated with Public Improvements.

Per the Amended and Restated Service Plan for Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3, City of Aurora, Colorado, prepared by White Bear Ankele Tanaka & Waldron, P.C., and dated April 3, 2020, the Service Area consists of approximately two hundred ninety-six (296) acres of mixed-use land, and is located north of East 6th Avenue, south of Interstate 70 and East Colfax Avenue, east of Gun Club Road, and west of Powhaton Road. The population at build-out is estimated to be approximately three thousand sixty-five (3,065) people.

In addition, the Public Improvements Acquisition and Reimbursement Agreement ("PIARA") by and between Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 1 and Aurora Crossroads LLC, ("Company" and "Developer") with an effective date of July 1, 2020, states, "...Company has incurred or intends to incur costs related to the financing, construction, and installation of Public Improvements that may be lawfully funded by the District under the Special District Act and the Service Plan, including without limitation: (a) the costs of labor and materials, furnishings and equipment; (b) the costs of insurance premiums, indemnity and fidelity bonds or other municipal or governmental charges lawfully levied or assessed; (c) the costs of surveys, appraisals, plans, designs, specifications, and estimates; (d) the costs, fees, and expenses of engineers, architects, construction management, financial consultants, accountants, legal advisors or other agents or employees; (e) the costs of demolition, removal, and relocation; (f) the costs or organizing the District; and (g) all other lawful costs as determined by the Board (the "District Eligible Costs")..." and, Covenants and Agreements No. 7.b., states, "The District anticipates issuing bonds, loans or other obligations (the "Bonds") in 2020, and shall use the proceeds of the Bonds (the "Proceeds") to reimburse the Company, for the Certified Eligible Costs concurrently or as soon as possible following the close of the Bonds."

The purpose of this Report is to verify costs associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements as authorized by Service Plan and according to PIARA, *Covenants and Agreements No. 5.b.*, "The District's Engineer shall review the invoices and other material presented to substantiate the District Eligible Costs and shall issue a cost certification in form and substance reasonably acceptable to the District declaring the total amount of District Eligible Costs associated with Public Improvements proposed for acquisition and/or reimbursement, and that such costs are reasonable and appropriate for the type of Public Improvements being constructed (the "Engineer's Cost Certification");".

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Schedio Group reviewed a total of \$474,220.09 in soft and indirect costs associated with design and construction of improvements. Of the \$474,220.09 reviewed, Schedio Group verified **\$341,061.58** to be associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements and therefore eligible for



Developer Reimbursement from the District to the Developer. See *Figure 1 – Summary of Verified Soft, Indirect and Hard Costs Segregated by Service Plan Category* below.

DETERMINATION OF PUBLIC PRORATION PERCENTAGE

Figure 2 – Determination of Public Proration Percentage below summarizes the Public and Private areas within the Service Area of Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District Nos. 1-3. The ratio of Total Public Area to Total Area yields a Proration Percentage that can be applied to select costs with both public and private components. Areas were taken directly from or derived from the Aurora Crossroads Gun Club/Colfax Preliminary Plat (unapproved). The Public Proration Percentage was calculated and applied as deemed appropriate by Schedio Group. See Exhibit A – Summary of Costs Reviewed for application of the Public Proration Percentage.

VERIFICATION OF COSTS

Schedio Group reviewed soft and indirect costs associated with the design and construction of Public Improvements. Schedio Group found costs associated with Public Improvements to be reasonable when compared to similar projects, during similar timeframes in similar locales.

VERIFICATION OF PAYMENTS

Schedio Group verified proofs of payments associated with the \$341,061.58 verified as eligible for Developer Reimbursement.

VERIFICATION OF CONSTRUCTION

Schedio Group did not perform a site visit for this verification as costs reviewed consisted of soft and indirect costs, with no hard costs being reviewed.

The Independent Consulting Engineer is an engineer duly qualified and licensed in the State of Colorado with experience in the design, construction and verification of Public Improvements of similar type and function as those described in the attached Engineer's Report dated October 23, 2020.

The Independent Consulting Engineer has reviewed applicable construction and legal documents related to the Public Improvements under consideration to state the conclusions set forth in this Engineer's Verification.

The Independent Consulting Engineer finds and determines that Public Improvements considered in the attached Engineer's Report, from June 13, 2019 (date of Special District Association invoice number 6.13.19) to October 22, 2020 (date of City of Aurora invoice number 623034), are reasonably valued at \$341,061.58.

In the opinion of the Independent Consulting Engineer, the above stated value for soft and indirect costs associated with the design and construction of the Public Improvements is reasonable and consistent with costs of similar improvements constructed for similar purposes during the same timeframe and similar locales and is eligible for Developer Reimbursement from Aurora Crossroads Metropolitan District No. 1 to Aurora Crossroads LLC.

The Developer has submitted documentation substantiating \$341,061.58 of expenditures for District Eligible Costs consisting of invoices and other supporting documentation (Exhibit A).

Schedio Group LLC, ("Schedio"), the District's independent engineer, has reviewed certain underlying documentation supporting Exhibit A and has submitted an engineering certification dated October 23, 2020 certifying that the District Eligible Improvements were complete and in satisfactory form and, in their opinion, that the District Eligible Costs are specifically contemplated and allowed under the Reimbursement Resolution, relate to the District Eligible Improvements, and are reasonable and within the fair market as to similar soft costs related to the District Eligible Improvements for similar purposes. Schedio also verified the payment of these costs.

Based upon the certification provided by Schedio, District Eligible Costs in the amount of \$341,061.58 should be reimbursed by the District to the Developer.

We read the Engineer's Certification and reviewed certain underlying documentation supporting Exhibit A as necessary and appropriate, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, to verify the accuracy of the cost summary set forth in Exhibit A and the related conclusions in the Engineer's Certifications. Based on the above described procedures, the costs set forth in Exhibit A represent reimbursable costs incurred for the completed District Eligible Improvements.
